Dear Pine Hill Parents:

The Regional Enrichment & Learning Center (REAL) would like to invite your child to participate in the Twilight Club's after school enrichment program that will be held in your child's school. The REAL Center is in partnership with the Mount Holly Public School District. Our partnership has been awarded a federal grant called the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Community Learning Centers. We are entering the fifth year of a five year grant.

The Twilight Program is available to students entering grades 3-4-5 and provides a curriculum that focuses on language arts, math, science, and character education. Programs will be held at both the Albert Bean and John Glenn Schools. New Jersey certified teachers teach and monitor your child's participation in all of the learning activities.

Your children will participate in activities that include academic remediation and homework, academic enrichment, clubs, character education and youth development, recreational activities, computer applications, art and entrepreneurial activities. The students often use computers with educational software. Students are scheduled to go on several field trips throughout the year. We will also offer a 4 week summer camp during the month of July 2019. Students receive a snack each day.

To pay for field trips and special events, the Twilight Club is available on a sliding scale fee to all who attend. The purpose of the grant is to assist in providing school age children with a safe haven that will provide them with the opportunity to improve academically and socially. The grant also serves families of our students, including parent workshops and family activities throughout the school year.

Please note that the Twilight Club begins on September 13, 2019.
